ORACION A SAN PABLO

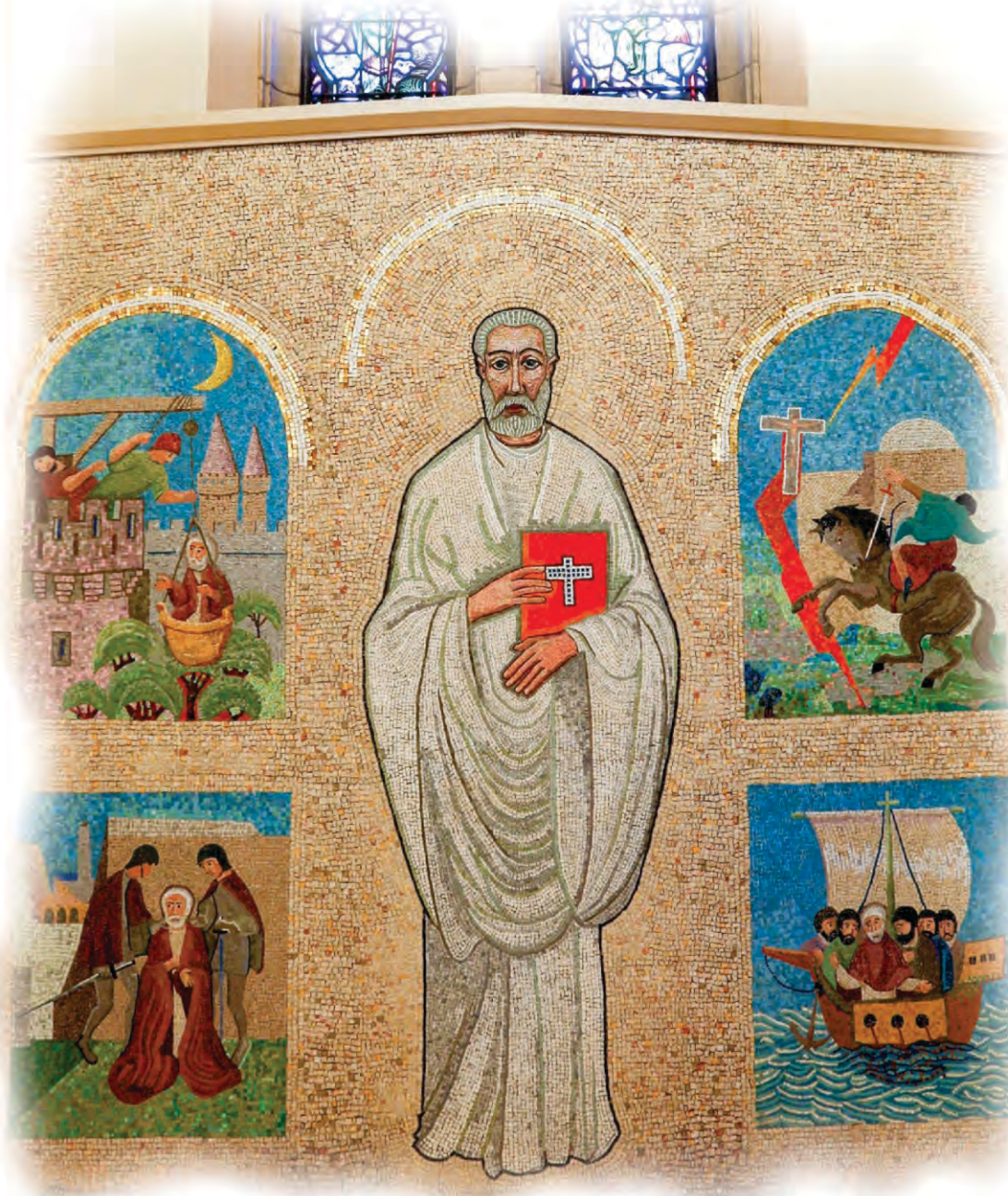
